#### Federal Construction Project Update

He spoke about the new multi-use path, the cycle track, and the first intersection in town where the green bike lane is being used. City projects reviewed included the Water Avenue Streetscape plan, the reconstruction of Salem Avenue, the Gibson Hill project, and the Queen Avenue project. Irish also spoke about the Albany-Corvallis path briefly. Irish updated the commission on the safe routes to school path projects. Lastly, Irish updated the commission on a project on Goldfish Farm Road. Ketter asked for an update on the Madison Avenue project; Irish spoke on where the project is now. Discussion ensued.
