#### Call to Order

**5:30 p.m.**

Chuck Kratch called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

#### Roll Call

#### Approval of March 28, 2023 minutes

**5:31 p.m.**

Chuck Kratch noted a correction to the scheduled business section of the March 25, 2023 minutes. There was no motion made regarding adding speed bumps instead of installing stop signs. Kratch made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. Frankie McCullough seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

#### Scheduled Business

**5:33 p.m.**

##### a. Update on Highway 20 Capacity Study

Ron Irish handed out a presentation\* by DKS Associates regarding a Highway 20 Traffic Analysis. Kratch asked if the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will be involved in this study. Irish confirmed that ODOT will be involved, and there will be a management team coordinating the work with ODOT, including a state traffic engineer. ODOT will need to agree with the process and will continue to be involved. Details of the Traffic Analysis Report were discussed.

##### b. Discuss Concerns of Commission Members

Frankie McCullough brought up his concerns on the length of time it takes once traffic improvement projects are approved and when the project begins. Irish explained the process.

##### c. Review Suggestion for Painted Intersection Program

Kratch confirmed painting works and shows benefits to traffic safety. Nolan Streitberger met with the Arts Commission and discussed the Painted Intersection Program. He also studied the intersections that are painted in Portland, Oregon, Corvallis, Oregon and Seattle, Washington and provided feedback of his findings.

Irish presented the Painted Intersection Program Flyer\*. Irish stated the City Attorney will need to be involved in the selection and design approval. The Transportation Advisory Commission would work together with the Arts Commission regarding design ideas. Once decisions have been made, the suggestions will be brought to the City Council for approval and agreement of the artwork, and financial contribution. Kratch asked for a straw vote to pursue investigating the program, and all members raised their hand.

Kratch suggested an Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) member attend a future meeting to go over current and scheduled projects in Albany.
